乾電池に関するご注意

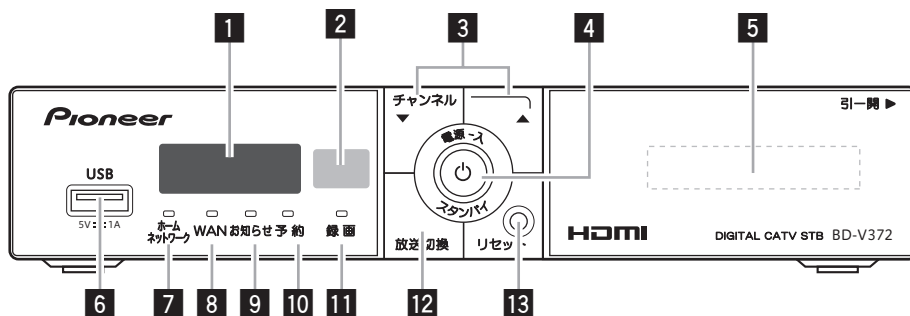
- 新しい電池と古い電池および種類の違う乾電池を混ぜて使わないでください。電池の破裂、液もれにより、火災・けがや周囲を汚損する原因となることがあります。
- 長期間（1 カ月以上）リモコンを使わないときは電池を取り出しておいてください。電池から液がもれて、火災・けが、周囲を汚損する原因となることがあります。

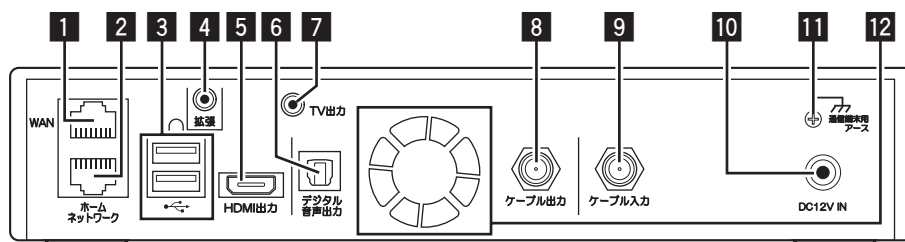

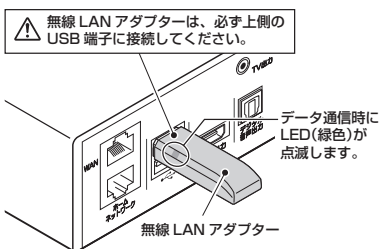

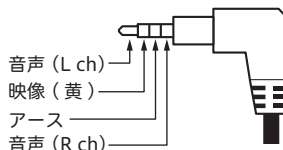
